- **AUXILIARY GIFT SHOP** - The gift shop is coordinated and staffed by Auxiliary members and high school volunteers. It offers a wide variety of gifts, cards, and holiday items.

- **DINE WITH FLAIR** - Dine with Flair began in the spring of 2005 as a special project fundraiser. Hostesses plan and decorate a table according to a theme, then invite eight people to enjoy a delicious brunch served by Auxiliary members.



- **FESTIVAL OF TREES**

- Organizations and individuals decorate themed holiday trees and wreaths, which are then sold at a silent auction.

- **GARDEN TOUR** -

- This annual tour highlights gardens in the Algona area.

- **LIFELINE** - The Auxiliary coordinates this easy-to-use personal response service that ensures older adults living at home a quick response whenever help is needed, 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
